We are teaming up with local professional associations to inspire high school students and teachers to widen their knowledge in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM). This educational outreach event will be held as follows:

This event is an opportunity for you to expand your professional network, meet NASA scientists, and learn about space science. You will also inspire students to pursue a STEM career.

On February 11, 150 high school students will participate in hands on learning about the NASA exploration, discoveries, and science. On Saturday, February 9th, 60 high school teachers will be introduced to Expedition Earth and Beyond (EEAB) learning resources. Teachers will also become certified to borrow lunar rocks and meteorites from NASA to share in the classroom.

NASA scientists and science education specialists will lead various educational sessions each day. Volunteers are provided by SHPE-DC, SHPE-US PTO, MAES-DC professional chapters, U.S. Navy officers and other community organizations for professionals.

We estimate that we will need you to serve for 2-4 hours to help coordinate this event. We will need most of the volunteers to help coordinate the high school student event on Monday, February 11th.
